

# Privacy Notice ‘OneArt Wallet’

We are **OneArt Digital OÜ**, (hereinafter OneArt Digital OÜ will be referred to as “we”) care about your personal data, and we do everything to protect it. This Privacy Notice was created to help you to understand how your personal data is collected, stored and processed and what happens if you use our [Website](#).

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## 1. Purpose of this Privacy Notice

Privacy Notice is a statement of us as a data controller to you (data subject) that describes how we collect, use, retain and disclose personal information.

### 3. Personal data we process

The data we process is divided into three categories: **technical information**, **users' data** and data that is provided by **third parties**.

**Technical information.** When you visit our Website, some data is collected automatically. We need technical data to operate, maintain, and improve our Website. This includes data such as IP address, UTM parameters, geolocation, device type, and data about your interaction with the Website – session ID.

The **session ID** includes your interaction with the Website, the functions you use, the pages viewed on our Website, the way you use our Website, and the actions you take if such actions are present.

#### Data provided by the user.

**Please note.** We only process your indirect personal data, nevertheless, you may be identified.

**Data Provided by the third parties.** Data that we can get from third resources like Name, Nickname, photo and phone.

**Pay your attention.** We knowingly **do not process** users' personal data under 18 without consent from a legal representative(s). If you are such a user or the user's legal representative, please let us know by email at [privacy@oneart.digital](mailto:privacy@oneart.digital).

## 4. Period of data storage

We store **automatically collected data** for up to 3 years.

We store **users'** data in our databases and in blockchain. Due to the blockchain nature, your wallet address is stored there for a really long time. In our databases we store your data while you use our services and 3 years after.

The length of time we can retain **data from third parties** is determined by their respective Privacy Notices.

You can exercise your right to delete your data. In this case, we will delete your data from our servers within 30 days from your request.

**Please note:** some data may be contained in documents that are required by law to be stored for a longer period of time (for example, accounting documents).

## 5. Sharing data with third parties

We use your personal data to perform a contract and for communication between the user and us. We use and transfer your personal data to the extent it is necessary to perform a contract. Also, we transfer your data on the following grounds:

**Consent.** We transfer your personal data based on your explicit consent.

**Compliance with the law.** We will disclose your personal data to third parties to the extent that it is necessary:

- to comply with a government request, court order, or applicable law;
- to prevent unlawful use of our Website or violation of our policies;
- to protect against claims of third parties;
- to help prevent or investigate fraud.

**Transfer to third parties:** We transfer your personal data to third parties based on a public offer for processing on our behalf, subject to technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data.

## 6. Your privacy right

You, as subjects of personal data, have the following rights:

<b>The right to access information.</b>	You can request an explanation of the processing of your personal data.
<b>The right to portability.</b>	You can request all the data that you provided to us, as well as request to transfer data to another controller.
<b>The right to restrict processing.</b>	You may partially or completely prohibit us from processing your personal data.
<b>The right to file complaints.</b>	If your request was not satisfied, you can file a complaint to the regulatory body.

<b>The right to be forgotten.</b>	You can send us a request to delete your personal data from our systems, unless there is a legal requirement to keep it.
<b>The right to withdraw consent.</b>	For data that you have previously consented to, you can always withdraw your consent and we will stop processing it.
